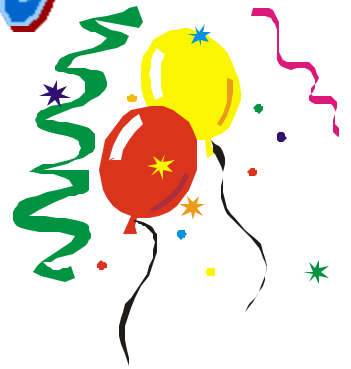

We need a firm commitment NOW. If you are willing and able to help, please complete the form below so that it is returned with your reservation form (on reverse side) and payment. You will be reminded of your commitment a few days before the event and provided specific details as to the exact time and location. You may volunteer for one or more Tasks (check box or boxes).

Task 1 Parking – This involves arriving early (2:00 to 2:30 pm) and directing traffic on July 6 (day of the picnic) to ensure that vehicles are systematically parked on Suzanne's and approved adjacent properties. If we get enough volunteers the job will be divided into specific time slots.

Task 2 Table setups – This includes helping the committee members to decorate, setup hors d'oeuvres, and other last minute preparations on the day of the picnic. We anticipate that arriving one hour early (2:00 pm) would be sufficient.

Task 3 Returning Tables and Chairs – This involves returning to the picnic site on Sunday afternoon (1 - 2pm), July 7th to return the tables and chairs to the Church of the Messiah on Route 202 near the William Penn Inn. If you have a truck and are willing to bring it check here .
